Vendor's Agreement

Terms:

- ◆ vendors do not have exclusivity over one product type
- ◆ vendors must sell authentic aboriginal items
- ◆ vendors must supply their own concession necessities, e.g. chairs, tables, tent, etc.
- ◆ vendors are responsible for their own cash security
- ◆ vendors must display the prices of their products
- ◆ vendors must not engage in price wars with other vendors
- ◆ vendors may only set up and sell in their designated areas, which will be assigned after acceptance of this signed contract and after all monies have been banked
- ◆ the designated area will be the only area in which products can be sold, displayed and advertised
- ◆ vendors are responsible for setting up and taking down their stands as well as all garbage clean up in their vending area
- ◆ vendors will come under the Penticton Peach Festival umbrella for a business license in the city park
- ◆ vendors must use approved RV water hoses and approved electrical cords if they intend to hook up to the City of Penticton services
- ◆ all applicable insurance, including naming Penticton Peach Festival as an additional insured, must be received with this application, and also posted in the booth

Set up Schedule:

Thursday evening, August 9: 7 pm to 9 pm

Friday, August 10: Gyro Park will be open for setup at 7:00 am

Vendors must be ready to sell their products by 10:00 am

Vendors must close at 11:00 pm as per city by-law

Saturday, August 11:

Vendors must be ready to sell their products by 10:00 am

Vendors must close at 11:00 pm as per city by-law

The ACV will be fenced and security will be onsite between 11:00 pm until 8:00 am on Friday and Saturday nights. Vendors must take down their booths by 10:00 am Sunday morning.

Vendor space is sold on a first come first served basis and requires insurance, with Penticton Peach Festival Aboriginal Cultural Village named as an additional insured, Foodsafe and the cheque to clear the bank before the space is allocated.
